**INTRODUCTION**

1. AUS has agreed the following measures with the organiser and airspace controlling authorities to accommodate the subject Unusual Aerial Activity.

**ACTIVITY**

2. An air display at RAF Odiham as part of the Families Day. The event will include an aerobatic displays by the Red Arrows and other military aircraft, helicopter displays, BBMF flypasts and a freefall parachute displays by the RAF Falcons and Red Devils parachute display teams.

## **AIRSPACE RESERVATIONS**

8. Restricted Area (Temporary) (RA(T)) will be established in accordance with Article 96 of the Air Navigation Order 2005 (Mil ac should comply with JSP 552.201.135.9) for the Red Arrows display on 25 July 2007 between 1155 -1233 hrs within 6nm radius 511416N 0005629W (RAF Odiham) up to 8,500ft amsl. AIC 33/2007 (Mauve 218) dated 26 April 2007 refers.

## **CO-ORDINATION ARRANGEMENTS**

9. ATC Authorities
- a. Air Traffic Control services will be provided by RAF Odiham ATC. Extended airspace up to FL120 may be requested tactically for Red Arrows and other high performance displays and the freefall parachute displays. The Odiham ATC supervisor will coordinate these requests directly with LTCC GS South and/or Farnborough ATC Supervisor (as appropriate) on a tactical basis.
- b. ATC Supervisors are to note that other aircraft are not cleared to penetrate the RA(T) during the Red Arrows display, regardless of whether or not they have ATC clearance. The airspace must remain sterile to all movements until the end of the display.
- c. Display participants are not to enter Controlled Airspace unless cleared by the appropriate ATC Agency.

d. Whilst within the airspace defined in para 8, above, military aircraft are exempt from the requirements to restrict their rates of climb or descent to a maximum of 8,000ft per minute, as per ENR 1-1-3-1 AIRAC 7/2007 effective 5 July 07

10. **Adjacent Airspace Users**

a. Operators and service providers have been advised of this activity by means of this ACN and associated NOTAM.

b. SATCO at RAF Odiham is requested to inform any adjacent airfields, not included on the distribution list, of this activity if considered necessary.

**RESTRICTIONS**

11. The Display Co-ordinator must take note of the following points regarding the conduct of the display:

a. The dedicated display radio frequency must not be used for anything other than essential emergency messages during an aircraft's display period. The frequency must not be used for passing administrative messages, regardless of their urgency, until the aircraft captain has acknowledged completion of the display.

b. Other aircraft are not cleared to penetrate the RA(T) during the Red Arrows display, regardless of whether or not they have ATC clearance. The airspace must remain sterile to all movements until the end of the display.

c. Unmanned balloons or kites are not to be flown during the period of any airborne activity. Should a balloon or kite be part of a display then it must be securely tethered and must be on the ground and/or deflated once airborne activity has commenced. (Note: This restriction does not apply to small balloons, kites etc on vendors stalls, provided that they are properly secured and are not flown at a height exceeding 10m.)

d. There must be no rotors or propellers turning at the airfield during the period of any parachute descents.

**AERONAUTICAL PUBLICATIONS**

12. a. AUS has arranged for the issue of a NOTAMs to cover this event.

b. The Display Co-ordinator is requested to copy this ACN to any air display aircrew not on the distribution list, prior to their participation.
